TRAVEL INFORMATION

Waco, Texas lovingly referred to as the heart of Texas experiences a mild seasonal variation of the course of a year with an average temperature of 66° Fahrenheit (18°C). Our hottest weather can be found in late May to late September with the average high above 89° Fahrenheit (31°C). Our coolest weather last for about 3 months and starts around late November and going until about late February, with average high below 66° Fahrenheit (18°C). The clearest skies can be found between the end of May to the middle of November. Our rainfall varies much through out the year. Our wetter season typically starts around mid October and ends around the end of June with only a 26% chance of rain or snow. Our windier part of the year is between late October and ends around the beginning of June. The average wind speed in those months is around 9.6 miles per hour (15.5 kmph).

Important Historical Facts about Waco

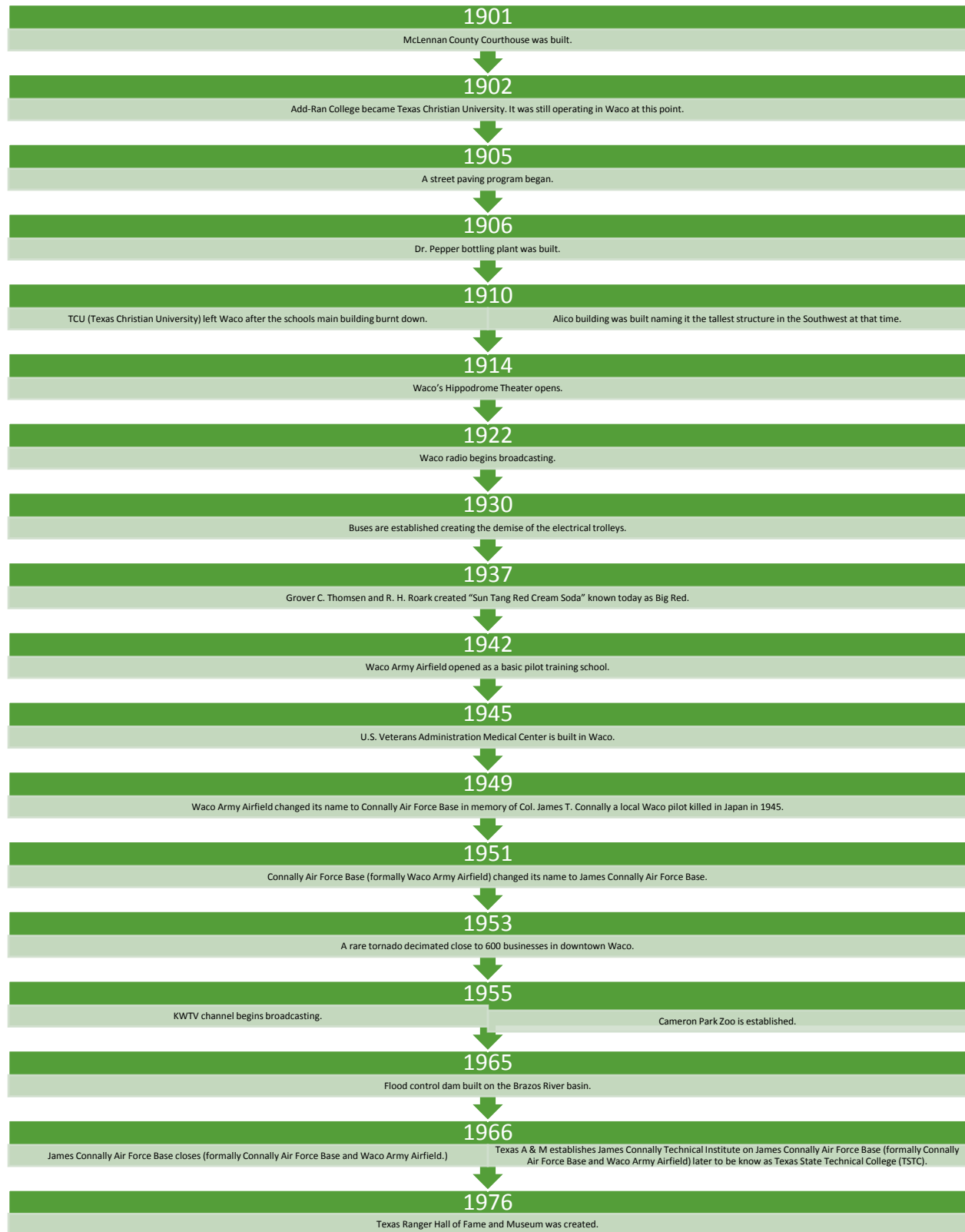
Located between Dallas/Fort Worth and Austin Waco has always been an important stop in the travel industry. This birthplace of Dr. Pepper and Big Red was essential during the Chisholm Trail days. De Cordova the owner of the land convinced Captain Shapley P. Ross to move to Waco. Ross known for being a Texas Ranger and Indian fighter established the first house where his wife soon after birthed the first child to be born in Waco (Kate Ross). Ross established and operated the ferry across the Brazos River, which was essential to traveling before the Suspension Bridge was created. He also opened the first hotel and served as the town's first post master. By 1871 six hundred to seven hundred thousand cattle had been driven through town. The suspension bridge, which is still standing in city of Waco, was important to the movement of all these cattle. The builder John A. Roebling later went on to build the famous Brooklyn Bridge. Waco was one of the leading producers of cotton, which was transported easily once all the railways were built intersecting throughout the city. By the 1890's the city had built a system of city parks to accommodate the ever-growing population and commuters. In the late 19th century artesian wells were drilled and 2 natatoriums were built so the city could advertise as a health resort. By 1901 Citizen Railway Company was operating 20 electric trolleys to help with movement around the City. By this time Waco was known for insurance and in 1910 the Alamo building was built naming it the tallest structure in the Southwest. In 1942 during World War II Waco became the leading manufacturer of armed forces cots, tents, mattresses and barrack bags.

Because of its ease of shipping and industrial notoriety it was chosen to be the new site of the General Tire and Rubber plant the first tire factory in the southwest. By the 1950's Waco was the sixth largest industrial center in Texas. By 1953 all of that was destroyed when the first ever tornado touched down in the city of Waco. On May 11th this tornado decimated close to six hundred businesses reaching F5 on the Fujita scale. It is known as the eleventh deadliest tornado in history and tied for the deadliest in Texas history. The heavy rains and baseball size hail obscured the tornado from view leaving the residents unaware of the danger involved. However, this tornado was the first to be tracked by the radar we still use today. More recently Texas State Technical College Airfield was used multiple times by U.S. President George W. Bush when on his way to visit his Prairie Chapel Ranch (also known as The Western White House) in Crawford Texas. The most recent notoriety to Waco is the reality television show Fixer Upper. The show began airing on May 2013 featuring Chip and Joanna Gaines who renovate and design houses in and around Waco. Realizing these two would be a hit HGTV (Home and Garden Television) began their first full season in April of 2014. By their third season in 2015 25 million people were tuning in each week. It quickly became HGTV's fifth highest rated show in history and cables number one program Tuesday nights at prime time. Unfortunately, the show completed it's final season in 2018 but Chip and Joanna can still be found around town from time to time and their Magnolia Silo's (Shopping), Magnolia Bakery, Magnolia House (Hotel) and Magnolia Table (Restaurant) are still thriving all around Waco.
